

SOUTH AMERICA

Diocese of Colombia
Bogota

Constructs a multipurpose building to serve as worship center, with conference and class rooms, housing for the priest, parish offices, and offices for medical and legal assistance in a southern community of Bogota city, serving families of the lowest socio-economical status.



EAST TENNESSEE

Chattanooga Community Kitchen

Purchases a truck to pick up donated items and help clients of the Community Kitchen, an independent interdenominational agency that relies solely on contributions to serve the homeless.



NORTH INDIA

Diocese of Cuttack

Starts a 10-acre agricultural development program with the goal of improving the economic status of the tribes and creating a self-sustaining project.

EAU CLAIRE

St. Katherine's Episcopal Church
Owen, WI

Replaces an older heating system, which is beyond repair, in a small rural church that is embarking on a program of growth and evangelization.

IDAHO

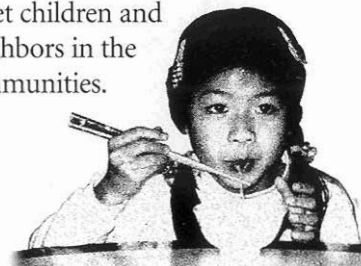
St. Michael's Cathedral

Builds houses in urban centers, to house families serving there and to be open houses for HIV/AIDS victims, war victims, street children and neighbors in the communities.



NEW JERSEY

Trinity After School Program
Vineland

Augments the existing after school program, addressing the educational, recreational and cultural needs of at least 25 at risk children in a lower income area.

CARRIBEAN REGION

Diocese of Dominican Republic

Builds a six-classroom second floor addition to the San Andres classroom annex, to expand and improve a school currently serving 625 students in a very poor section of Santo Domingo.
