**Right On School Peace Initiative**

To implement peace and reconciliation training with children attending an established summer school program, serving an area with high levels of poverty and violence.

**Louisiana**

**Diocesan Office of Disaster Response**

To help renovate a building which will serve as the Office of Disaster Response for the Diocese of Louisiana, housing office staff, displaced survivors, and volunteer groups.

**Northern Michigan**

**Camp New Day**

To expand services of an ecumenical camp for children who have a family member in prison, by providing bus transportation and adding insurance.

**Pennsylvania**

**St. John's Episcopal Church**

To construct a unisex bathroom accessible to persons with disabilities; the parish has a school for autistic children, and this new restroom will allow them to accept autistic children with profound physical disabilities.



**South Dakota**

**Blackfoot**

To build a guild hall so that this Native American congregation can have meeting space appropriate for many church and community activities, with an indoor bathroom and running water.

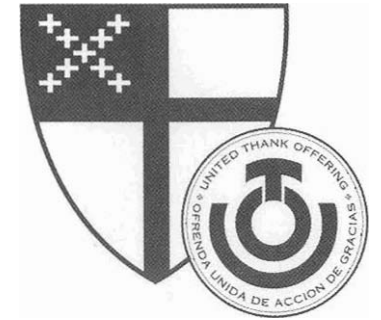
