To add a dining room and staff
quarters to a Home for the Aged
serving homeless, impoverished,
elderly Anglican parishioners.

with disabilities by
widening the doors
and constructing a
ramp, as well as
refitting a restroom.

Seven Hills Homeless Center –
*Supportive Services Initiative,
Fayetteville*

To fund start-up salary for a part-time
social worker at this homeless center
which provides shelter, food, life skills
training, and support to promote
independent living.

Haven of Hope for Kids – *Family Retreat
House Upgrades, Hope, NJ*

To purchase a van, construct a
wheelchair ramp, and purchase
laundry equipment, all to better serve
families with seriously ill children
who come to this retreat house.
